## THE SCHOOL

Immanuel Schools was founded in 1926 as a Bible School by members of the Mennonite Brethren Church. In 2004, the school grew into a full K-12 District. Our campus is located on a beautiful 13.5 acres overlooking the Kings River in Reedley. Immanuel added a 50 acre sports complex in 2015, which houses eight tennis courts, two baseball and two softball diamonds, and is the home to County Line Stadium.

Accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, Immanuel Schools has a long history of providing a quality, Christ-centered education to families in the Central Valley. Our student population comes from a diverse and wide-spread area, currently residing in 4 counties and 22 cities. Smaller average class sizes (K-6=22 / 7-12=23) allow for more one-on-one instruction.

## Continues Enrollment Growth

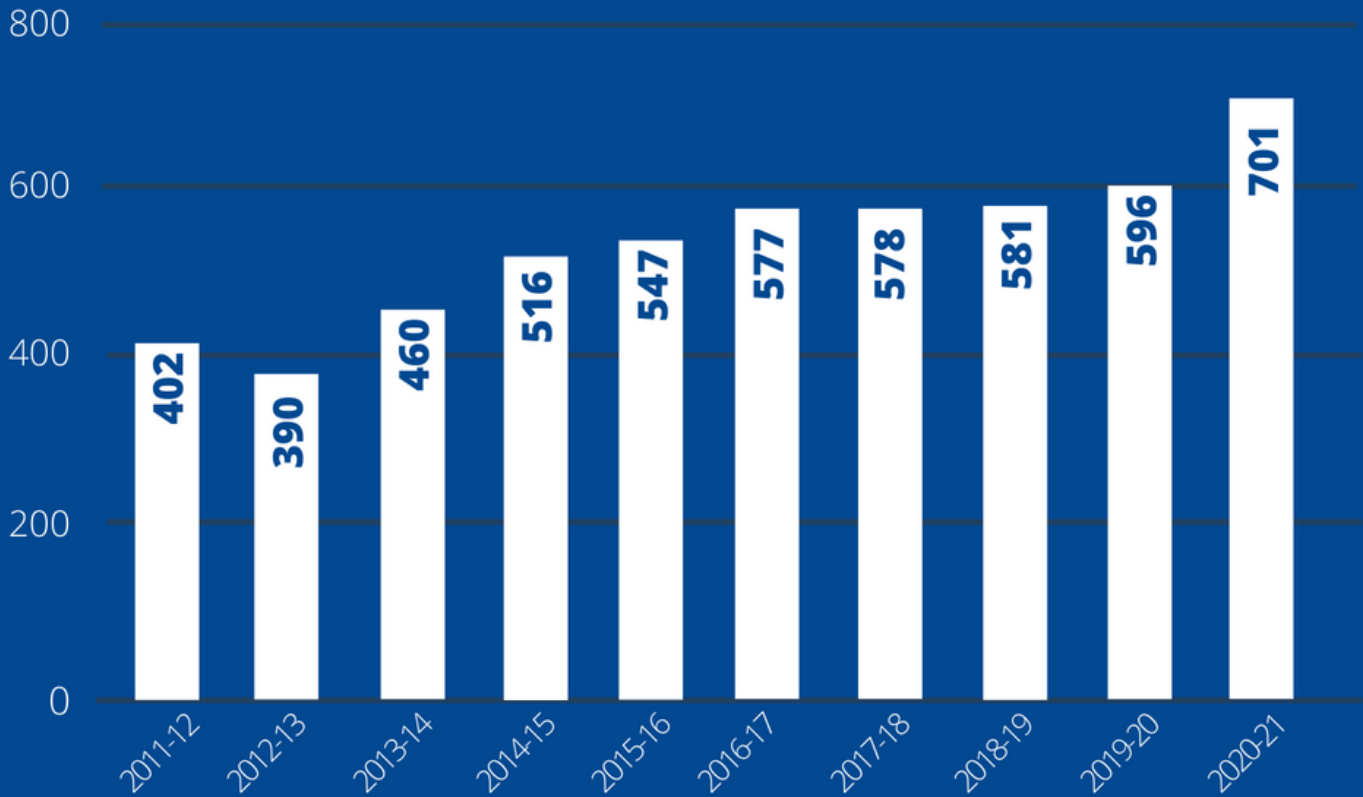

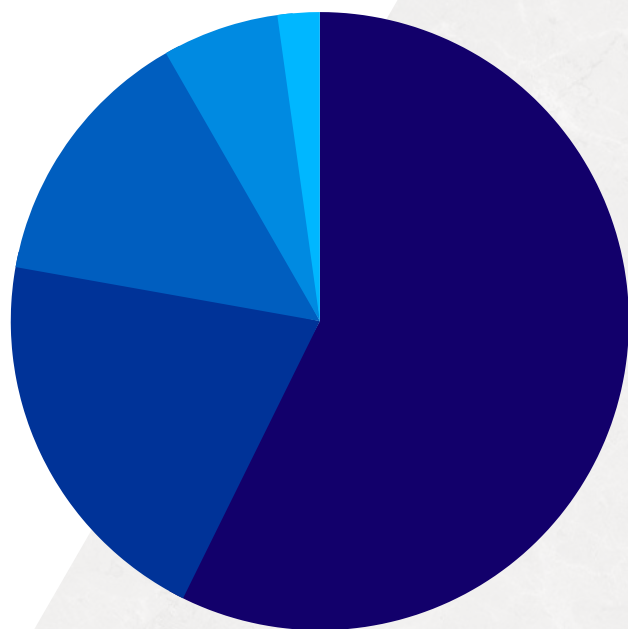

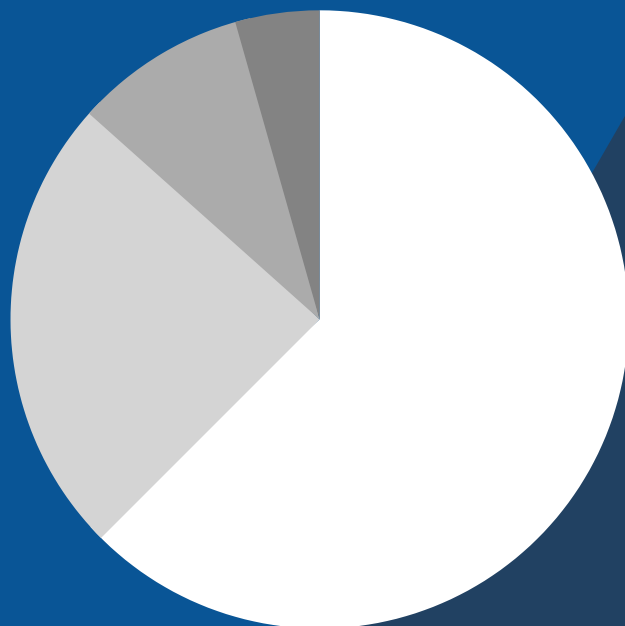

## Stewardship Giving Reflects a Generous Community

We believe an Immanuel education should be accessible to all families who value and are committed to its mission. We know a private school education is not inexpensive, but we believe the return on investment is worth every penny. For families who are unable to afford the stated tuition, they may apply for our newly established Flex Tuition Program. The Flex Tuition Program is designed to ensure inclusion and affordability by matching a families tuition rate to the families unique financial situation. This is made possible through donations made to the Stand in the Gap program, a subset of the Eagle Fund. In the 2020-2021 school year 191 students were able to attend Immanuel with a reduced tuition rate, for a combined total of \$627,000 savings for families.
