**CLASS SCHEDULES:** The FACTS Family Portal is being updated with classroom teacher information. You will be able to view your student(s) schedule at noon today (Monday, August 4th). Simply log into your Family Portal to view your student(s) schedule for next year. Our district code is IS-CA. Each student should have 7 classes. If you are missing a class it could be due to schedule conflicts or a course not offered. **CHRISTIAN SERVICE HOURS:** All high school students are required to log their Christian service hours. Returning students, sign in and log your service hours for summer and the 24-25 school year via Cleaver on the X2VOL app. New students will receive their log in when school starts.

**BIBLES:** It is our desire that students start carrying their Bibles to Chapel each Tuesday and Thursday and to their Bible classes. Please be sure your high school students have a physical Bible (preferably an ESV translation).

**LOCKERS:** All 9th-12th grade students may choose their lockers and must provide their own lock, they can do this during our Back to School Night (Aug. 11th) or their first day of school (Aug. 13th). Lockers are first-come, first-served. The office will not be responsible for keeping track of combinations or keys, that will be the responsibility of the student. High school lockers are optional and are available in Alumni Hall.

**PE LOCKERS:** Students in PE and/or a sport will be able to choose a locker in their respective PE locker room. They can bring their own lock on the first day of school. The office will not be responsible for keeping track of combinations or keys, that will be the responsibility of the student.

**PE CLOTHES:** PE clothes are required for all 7th-12th grade students enrolled in a PE class. They will be available for purchase during our Back to School Night on August 11th. When you arrive at Back to School Night you will purchase them in person and be handed the PE clothes right away. In the chance we run out of a specific size, we will place another bulk order. (8th-grade students may continue to use the Immanuel PE clothes they purchased last year.)
