## **CONFESSION OF FAITH**

## **IMMANUEL SCHOOLS**

The following is a statement of faith to which all staff must subscribe.

- 4. That the Holy Spirit is a person, is God and is co-equal with the Father and the Son; convicts the world of sin, righteousness and judgment; regenerates and indwells the believer, is his constant guide and teacher, and is the enabling power for victorious living and dedicated service. John 14:26, 16:7-8,13; Titus 3:5; Acts 1:8.
- 5. That man was created in the image of God, that he sinned, and thereby incurred for himself and the whole human race not only physical death, but also spiritual death, which is separation from God. Romans 5:12; Genesis 1:26-27.
- 6. That the Lord Jesus Christ died for man's sins, according to the Scriptures, and that all who believe on Him have the forgiveness of sins through His blood. I Corinthians 15:3; Ephesians 1:7.
- 7. That Christ arose bodily from the dead and ascended into heaven where He is now the believer's High Priest and Advocate. I Corinthians 15:4; Hebrews 7:25.
