The Gates Scholarship – Highly competitive last-dollar scholarship

Deadline: September 15, 2025

To be eligible:

- Must be a high school senior.
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Minimum GPA of 3.3.
- Pell-eligible (financial need).
- Ideal candidates are in the top 10% of their graduating class, demonstrate leadership, emotional maturity, motivation, and perseverance.

Coca-Cola Scholars Program – \$20,000 – 150 Awards

To be eligible:

- Must attend a U.S. college, university, or vocational/trade school.
